Pursuant to City of Humble Automated Red Light Enforcement Ordinance, the owner of a motor vehicle is liable for payment of a minimum civil penalty of \$75.00 if the owner's vehicle proceeds into an intersection equipped with a photographic intersection monitoring system when the traffic control signal for that vehicle's direction of travel is emitting a steady red signal. It has been determined that your vehicle has proceeded into an intersection as defined by Section 541.303 of the Texas Transportation Code when the traffic control signal, for the direction in which your vehicle was traveling, was emitting a steady red signal. Failure to pay the civil penalty or contest liability by the Due Date is an admission of liability in the full amount of the civil penalty assessed on this notice of violation and constitutes a waiver of the right to appeal under City's ordinance. Failure to pay the civil penalty or contest liability by the Due Date is an admission of liability in the full amount of the civil penalty assessed on this notice of violation and constitutes a waiver of the right to appeal under City's ordinance. Failure to pay the civil penalty or to contest liability within the time allowed will result in a \$25.00 late fee and may result in the County Tax Assessor-Collector refusing to register the vehicle alleged to have been in violation of this ordinance.

You have the right to contest the imposition of the civil penalty by sending a request for a hearing so that it is received by the Due Date printed on the front of this Notice of Violation. The civil penalty may not be recorded on the owner's driving record and an arrest warrant may not be issued.

You also may get access to internet from your local Public Library.

REQUEST AN ADMINISTRATIVE ADJUDICATIVE HEARING: You must sign the coupon below and mail it in the enclosed envelope. A non-judicial administrative hearing will be scheduled and you will be notified of the location, date and time of your hearing. Failure to pay a civil penalty or to contest liability in a timely manner is an admission of liability in the full amount of the civil penalty assessed in the notice of violation and constitutes a waiver of the right to appeal under Ordinance No. 07-835 of the City of Humble, Texas. If you are found liable at the non-judicial administrative hearing or you request a hearing and thereafter fail to appear at the time and place of the hearing, you will also be liable for administrative hearing costs in the amount of \$50.00. A person who is found liable for a civil penalty after a non-judicial administrative hearing shall pay the civil penalty and costs within 10 days of the determination of liability.

YOU MAY ONLY SUBMIT A DECLARATION OF NON-LIABILITY IF YOU ARE IN THE BUSINESS OF RENTING OR LEASING VEHICLES OR IF THE VEHICLE WAS SOLD OR REPORTED STOLEN AT THE TIME OF THE VIOLATION. you may submit a sworn statement to that effect to the administrative adjudicative hearing officer to rebut the presumption, that you were driving the vehicle at the time of the violation. Complete and mail a notarized declaration to CITY OF HUMBLE, Violation Processing Center, 209 W. Main Street, Mesa, AZ 85201.

To complete the Declaration of Non-Liability form, fill out the requested information and provide one of the following:

- (a) A copy of the Sales/Renters agreement;
- (b) A copy of the police report if the vehicle was stolen; or
- (c) The seller's report if ownership of the vehicle was transferred by the owner before the date of violation; the true name, address and driver's license of the new owner is required.

IF YOU ARE A RENTAL CAR COMPANY send your letter identifying the driver along with the copy of this Notice to Violation Processing Center, 209 W. Main Street, Mesa, AZ 85201.
